Department of Transport Student Travel Subsidy

The Department of Transport (DoT) Student Travel Subsidy for mainland WA* has been approved for 2025.

*Christmas Island students will be able to apply for a 25% refund of travel costs

There are different processes and criteria for students who

- 1. Reside in the Defined Remote Area
- 2. Families who use a private vehicle to drive students to their educational institution Only available to students being driven to camp. Bus travel is not subsidised.

For students residing in the Defined Remote Area who wish to apply for a voucher to pay for flights, **early action is required** as form ODT56 can be submitted up to 3 months https://www.transport.wa.gov.au/aboutus/student-travel-subsidies.asp
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- 1. Students Residing in the Defined Remote Area
 - a. Complete Student Registration form ODT55. If this form has been previously completed a new registration is not

required. State your child's school as GT ONLINE PERTH MODERN SCHOOL

You will receive an email from the Department of Transport confirming your registration.

b) Complete ODT56 Application for Refund – Travel Voucher Form

The application for a travel voucher must be emailed to perthmodern.gtonline@education.wa.edu.au as soon as possible to be issued a travel voucher by DoT to book travel to camp

You will be returned the form with a Confirmation of Enrolment signed by the Program Coordinator

Submit the ODT56 and ODT 58 Customer Account Creation Form (ODT58 is only required if you have not received a refund in the past or your bank account details have changed)

2. Families who use a private vehicle to drive students to their educational institution

a) Complete Student Registration form <u>ODT55</u>. If you have claimed for a camp before, then this has already been done. State your child's school as GT ONLINE PERTH MODERN SCHOOL Email form to odtcustomerservice@transport.wa.gov.au

You will receive an email from the Department of Transport confirming your registration.

b) Complete ODT57 Application for Refund- Road Travel Subsidy
State the Nearest Government School as GT ONLINE PERTH MODERN SCHOOL
Calculate the Distance from Home in Kms One Way from your home to the campsite.
Nearest Passenger Transport Service Centre and Distance can be left blank.

Complete Trip Details for Home > Camp + Camp > Home as required

ODT57 must be emailed to perthmodern.gtonline@education.wa.edu.au immediately after camp for confirmation of enrolment. Parents then email OdT Customer Service ondemandtransport@transport.wa.gov.au the following documents.

- ODT57 Application for Refund Form returned from the Program Coordinator with Enrolment Confirmation completed
- ODT58 Customer Account Creation-Travel Subsidy Form for reimbursement payment.

Reimbursement of the costs must be applied for within one month of the end of camp
