

GT Online CAMP BEHAVIOUR CONTRACT

In giving consent for your child to attend camp, you and your child agree to the listed responsibilities and behaviours.

All students need to have a clear understanding of these expectations before they attend camp.

Be respectful and act responsibly

- Follow all instructions issued by supervising staff
- Follow the camp itinerary and be prompt for all meetings and activities
- Be prepared to participate in all activities and strive to be part of the group
- Keep together with the activity group, and do not go anywhere by yourself
- Do not enter any dormitory other than your own, unless given permission by a teacher
- Stay within the designated communal areas of the campsite
- Immediately report unidentified strangers or inappropriate contact by any person
- Do not photograph other students without their consent
- Hand in your mobile phone on arrival at camp and accept restricted phone use during camp

Create a safe environment for everyone

- Follow all recommended hygiene practices
- Do not possess or consume alcohol or take cigarettes, vapes or non-prescribed drugs
- Advise supervising staff and seek assistance immediately if unwell, injured or have any safety concerns
- Stay seated and maintain a calm environment during mealtimes and clean up after yourself
- Look after your belongings, making sure everything is clearly labelled with your name
- Keep the dormitory area tidy, and respect the space of others in the room
- Follow bedtime and lights out rules, respecting the need for a quiet environment for others
- Assist staff entry into dormitory rooms if requested

The Program Coordinator can withdraw an invitation to camp if consistent poor behaviour, attitude or attendance have negatively impacted a student's Good Standing in the program.

Where a student has breached this contract, parents or their nominated representative, may be requested to collect the child from camp.
