What to Bring

- Please pack carefully and only bring what you will need for the time you are away.
- All property should be clearly labelled.
- Spending money is not required whilst on camp. Students travelling unaccompanied by bus/train/plane will need to have money to purchase lunch on Day 1 and 5.
- You will be visiting Perth Modern School and other external venues so please include appropriate smart casual clothing and enclosed shoes.
- No torn or faded jeans, brief shorts or skirts, midriff tops, T-shirts with inappropriate slogans. If these are worn you will be asked to go back and change.
- There is a loan pool of GT Online shirts; students collect a shirt on their arrival at camp and return it at the end of camp.

 Any purchased shirts from earlier years that you have outgrown will be gratefully received to add to the loan pool.
- Sleeping bag and a pillowcase
- A variety of daily clothing including changes and spares for 4 x days/nights.
- Enclosed shoes: required at the campsite and Perth Modern School
- Jacket/jumper and long pants for evening/cooler weather
- · Wet weather gear
- Pyjamas
- Underwear and socks
- Hat preferably sunsmart
- Personal toiletries (NO aerosol)
- · Prescription medication (as required)
- Bath towel

- Small backpack to take on off-site excursions: big enough to carry water bottle, pencils and paper
- Water bottle (1L max)

- Mobile phones (labelled with name) are permitted. To be handed in on arrival at camp with agreement to the condition of limited daily access.
